This year, Let's Fund It provided **€3,710.73** worth of goods and products for the service users of 10 hard-working charities. This is an increase of €528 compared to last year! Who Are They?

Deel Animal Rescue was established to rescue and assist in the rescue of unwanted, abandoned and mistreated dogs and cats; including the fostering and rehoming. The charity is run by volunteers.



How We Helped

Let's Fund It donated requested items from a list provided by Deel Animal Action Group. The list included items such as XL Pet Cushions, XS Pet Beds, Vet Beds, Greyhound food, Jelly Pouches, Pet Collars and Dentastixs. The total cost of this project was **€301.86**.

Who Are They?

Limerick Treaty Suicide Prevention is a Limerick based charity that patrols the bridges of the Shannon River 4 nights a week offering support to those who are distressed, struggling or may be at risk of suicide.

How We Helped

Let's Fund It donated 6 x Palm 25m Throwlines to Limerick Treaty Suicide Prevention. LTSP will use these throwlines as part of their operations. Throwlines are used by volunteers to aid in river rescues. Let's Fund It delivered the throwlines to LTSP and took part in two night patrols with the group. The total amount of this donation was **€401.70**.





Who Are They?

Limerick Animal Welfare (LAW) provides a safe haven for unwanted or abandoned animals until a safe, responsible and permanent home is found for them. Over the past 36 years, thousands of previously unwanted dogs, cats, horses, goats and a wide range of other animals have passed through LAW.

How We Helped

Let's Fund It donated a large selection of canned dog food, dog nuts, cat milk, cat food as well as kitten and puppy food to Limerick Animal Welfare in October 2021. The total amount of this donation was **€401.61**.

Who Are They?

Milford Care Centre is a voluntary, not-for-profit organisation and registered charity. It was first established by the Little Company of Mary Sisters in 1928 and now provides Specialist Palliative Care and Older Persons Services in the Mid-West.

How We Helped

This is Let's Fund It third consecutive donation to Milford Care Centre. Let's Fund It donation this year consisted of 7 Alvital Pulse Oximeters at €35 each, 3 Braun Thermoscan Ear at €48 each and 1 Box of 800 Braun Probe Covers at €48. The total of this donation came to **€436.95**.



Who Are They?

St. Munchin's Community Centre is a community enterprise centre in the heart of Limerick, that offers many services to the wider Limerick community. St. Munchin's provides a variety of social enterprises such as a Meals on Wheels service, a Community Café, a Seniors Clubs, a Friendly Call Service to name but a few!

How We Helped

Let's Fund It reached out to St. Munchin's Community Centre again this year, the second year running to offer a donation. We spoke to Linda Ledger, the Manager of St. Munchin's and offered to help offered a donation of gifts, treats and chocolates for the Senior Citizens Christmas Party. Let's Fund It compiled a donation of 150 chocolate gift bags and 40 boxes of chocolates. This delivery was completed by Let's Fund it on Tuesday, 30th November 2021. The total cost of this project was **€290.72**.

Who Are They?

Novas is a voluntary organisation and Approved Housing Body working with families and single adults who are disadvantaged and socially excluded; primarily those who are homeless or at risk of being homeless. Novas now provide a range of services and accommodation for marginalised households throughout Ireland.

How We Helped

Let's Fund It supplied 6 x €25 Penneys' Gift Cards as well as 6 x €25 Smyths' Gift Cards for the Novas Christmas Toy Appeal. This would give 12 children a meaningful and open gift for Christmas and allow them the freedom to choose what they wished to get. David visited both Smyths and Penneys and purchased the 12 vouchers. We know these vouchers will go to great use, making 12 special children happy over the Christmas period. The total cost of this project was **€300**.



Who Are They?

BUMBLEance is the official Children's National Ambulance Service of Ireland. It provides safe and comfortable transportation for Ireland's youngest patients as they travel between their homes and hospitals, hospices, treatment centres, and respite centres nationwide.

How We Helped

BUMBLEance are currently in the process of creating a new BUMBLEance vehicle for the road and said that they would love to have an iPad so that children can watch videos and play games on it during their journey. Let's Fund

It were more than happy to source and supply this for BUMBLEance. The total cost of this project was **€389**.

Who Are They?

The Children's Ark of University Hospital Limerick supports children through their stay in hospital. The Ark provides support through its staff and playroom activities such as painting, drawing, reading, games and so on.



How We Helped

Let's Fund It organised 200 goodie bags for the children of the Children's Ark. These goodie bags were full of toys, sweets and other treats to cheer up the children as they visited hospital. The goodie bags were distributed over the Christmas period. The total donation amounted to **€269.06**.



Who Are They?

Engage in Education are an experienced team of educators, business and community activists who support and encourage individual students to realise their potential, using the education system with support and encouragement. Engage supports young through primary school, second level and through to college graduation in their community setting, working with students and families. They work with students, parents and schools throughout Limerick.

How We Helped

Engage in Education reached out to Let's Fund It by email to inform us of the work they do and to see could we collaborate on a project together. A meeting was held with John Roche, Manager of Engage, who told us that Engage have recently opened a new section of their office and could use a new monitor or screen to use when giving presentations to students and their parents. Let's Fund It supplied a 43' Samsung Smart TV and this was delivered to the Engage Office. Total Cost for this project was **€449.97**.

Who Are They?

ADAPT Domestic Abuse Services is a voluntary organisation which was set up in 1974 to provide a wide range of supports to women survivors of domestic abuse and their children across Limerick City and County. ADAPT runs the largest refuge in the country providing emergency accommodation for women and children who have to leave their homes due to domestic abuse. It also provides a wide range of outreach services for women who are not staying in the Refuge.



How We Helped

Let's Fund It approached ADAPT by email to offer support. Gillian Baker, the Head of Communications and Fundraising told us that they are always looking for appliances and equipment for the self-contained apartments at the Refuge that the women and families live in. With this information Let's Fund It supplied the following requested items: 5 Two-slice toasters, 5 Kettles, 7 Frying Pans, 4 Clothes Airers. Let's Fund It visited the Adapt REFUGE in Limerick to make the delivery and met with Gillian. She gave us a great insight into the work that they do and showed us around the Refuge. The total cost of this donation was **€464.86**.
